An intermediate range which keeps its promises

For the last 10 years, DECO machines have stood for the ultimate in automatic turning machines, high levels of precision, unrivalled productivity, up to 11 axes (plus C axes) depending on the model, they enable numerous users (over 6000 machines sold) to do 'the impossible' day after day. Customers who need no convincing of the unique kinematics of these machines were obliged, even for the production of more straightforward parts, to purchase the complete product.. The widespread trend of no longer buying machines with 'capacity reserves' but instead opting for models which are more finely suited to the parts required has forced the manufacturer to react.

The latest DECO 'e' range is a response to this trend. It is a full range, with 4 models, capacities of 7/10 mm, 13 mm, 20 mm and 26 mm. The first 'e' machine was unveiled in 2007 and over 80 units have been sold, proof that the demand is well and truly there. With a full range, Tornos now propose an alternative to the DECO models in all diameters and to the Sigma models in diameters of 20 and 32 mm.

These 'more straightforward' machines do not compromise on quality or precision: in actual fact these are simply turning machines fitted with one less independent tool system. The most elaborate or complex workpieces are out of its range, although straightforward does not mean simplistic. To look at a workpiece cut and finished without rework on a DECO 13e at Siams is to be convinced. For the first time in the history of Tornos (over 100 years), a part such as a barrel drum has been finished on an automatic turning machine.
