Tornos embraces the future of turning at EMO Milano 2021

Moutier, Switzerland, September 23, 2021—With a stand at the heart of the EMO Milano 2021 exhibition and its Customer Center Milan just a short walk from the train station Rho-Fiera and minutes by car from the Fiera Milano fairgrounds, Tornos this year leverages proximity to roll out the red carpet for guests. In this respect, EMO Milano 2021 is the perfect opportunity for Tornos to launch its new range of Swiss DT machines. Designed to evolve with manufacturers' needs, the new Swiss DT range was conceived to meet the diverse requirements for machining long and short parts from bar stock measuring 2 to 38 mm diameter. Thanks to Tornos' 130 years of experience in bar turning, the Swiss DT range is an affordable solution that offers the market's best value. The machine is based on relatively traditional kinematics with five linear axes. Highly complex parts can be produced by adding a range of options compatible with all Tornos machines.

The Swiss DT range is designed for special operations. For example medical threads can be produced by adding a thread-whirling device, making it is possible to create a polyaxial screw for spinal surgery on a Swiss DT 26. Polygon milling or gear hobbing is also possible.

The Swiss DT range is of course one of the highlights of EMO Milano 2021, but it will not be the only machine to take the stage. For example, Tornos' SwissDECO 36 now has a new option for machining bars up to 42 mm in diameter.

Since its launch, the SwissDECO has become the reference for bar turning machines producing large-diameter, complex parts. Its power and infinite possibilities have enabled the production of parts that have been impossible to machine until now. Fast and precise, this machine is particularly well suited to the production of highly complex parts. Now, a new 42 mm option has been added to the broad range of options already offered by the SwissDECO.

Among the other machines Tornos will showcase at EMO Milano 2021 is the superbly flexible and productive MultiSwiss which allows manufacturers to get on the fast track to success. Thank to this machine, it is possible to quintuple productivity and immediately start producing parts up to eight times longer than the bar diameter.

The MultiSwiss platform meets your need to machine 3 to 32 mm bars and it is the most competitive solution for production of different types of parts. Boost your productivity by replacing up to 5 Swiss-type machines with 1 MultiSwiss and take your productivity per square meter to a new level.
